

Martin Luther King Jr. Day

The campaign to establish Martin Luther King Jr. Day as a federal holiday began soon after Dr. King's assassination in 1968, when activists and lawmakers, led by figures like Rep. John Conyers and Coretta Scott King, repeatedly introduced legislation in Congress to honor his legacy.

Despite early resistance to it, the movement gained public momentum in the late 1970's and early 1980's, helped in part by Stevie Wonder's 1980 song "Happy Birthday". The song, from Wonder's "Hotter than July" album, was an ode to King's vision, his achievements, and a rally cry for them to be recognized.

After years of petitions and persistent advocacy, Congress passed the bill in 1983 and President Ronald Reagan signed it into law, establishing the holiday on the third Monday of January and the first national observance took place in 1986.

Even after federal recognition, some states delayed full adoption or combined it with other commemorations, but by early 2000s all 50 states observed the holiday.

Later efforts, such as the King Holiday and Service Act of 1994, encouraged Americans to mark the day with community service, promoting MLK Day not just as a day off but "a day on" in service of others.
